Resolution

ISA bylaws (Article III, Section 1(A)), provide:

The Board, from time to time by resolution adopted by Special Board Approval, may establish one or more classifications of Affiliate Members. Affiliate Members shall have a direct educational, technical, regulatory or business relationship with the Regular Members or the industrial distribution channel. Provided, however, that persons or entities meeting the eligibility requirements to become a Regular Member or an Associate Member may not become an Affiliate Member.

BE IT RESOLVED, that professional and management services firms are not considered by ISA to be a classification of businesses eligible to obtain affiliate membership (or renew if already an affiliate member). Such firms include, but are not limited to, management service firms, accounting and tax firms, employment recruiting and placement firms, and law firms.
